****ON-LINE REGISTRATION****

This is a one day program open only to WIS 5th Grade students. Anyone planning to rent equipment should do so locally for maximum ski time. The Mt. Southington waiver form **must** be completed. This form is on our website. It must be returned to the Parks & Rec. office by February 10th by fax 222-2587, mail: P.O. REGISTRATION: Online Registration: Begins on Tuesday, Feb 4th at 12:01 a.m. at www.westonct.gov. Payment made by credit card online only or if you are paying in the office it is by cash or check to “Town of Weston”. You may not pay by credit card in the Recreation office. Please do not send your check through school.

Walk in Registration: Begins on Tuesday, Feb 4th at 9:30 a.m. in the Recreation office at 47 Norfield Rd. if space is available.

Early registration is encouraged and recommended. This program will fill up quickly. Prior to registration online make sure you have your Web Trac user and I.D. and password setup. If you already have an account make sure your information has been updated (i.e. address, age, grade, health, etc.). Registration ends on Friday February 7th at 4:00 p.m. in the Recreation Department.

TIME: Depart at rear of WIS approximately 12:35 p.m. and return in front of the WIS at approximately 7:30 p.m.

We will accept the first 48 students who register, after which we will put others interested on a wait list, call 203-222-2655 to be placed on wait list if you don't get in. We will know by Feb 6th if there is enough interest for another bus.

SKIING FEES

\$60.00 - lift ticket & transportation

\$70.00 - lift ticket, lesson & transportation

All skiers must wear helmets. Transportation is provided via coach bus. No spaces held by phone calls. Ski equipment must be dropped off at the WIS cafeteria stage in the morning between 7:45 a.m. – 8:00 a.m. prior to the normal morning school rush. All equipment left there is at the **owner's responsibility.** All equipment must be clearly labeled with your child's name. The Recreation Department and the Intermediate School assume **no responsibility** at all for theft or vandalism!

Bring a lock for equipment. Pack snacks or send money for your child to purchase food at the lodge.
