

Weston Annual Town Budget Meeting

Present: (*Head Table*) First Selectman Gayle Weinstein, Town Administrator Tom Landry, Finance Director Rick Darling, Board of Finance Chairman Steve Ezzes, Superintendent of Schools Dr. Colleen Palmer, Dr. JoAnn Keating, Legal Counsel Patricia Sullivan, Denise Harvey and Donna M. Anastasia, Clerk of the Meeting.

The voting procedures and rules were read including eligibility to vote.

Motion: A motion was made to waive the reading of the Call, motion seconded and approved unanimously. Attached is the Call of the meeting.

Lucy Bowden, Stonehenge Rd asked if we would be able to do anything tonight at this meeting due to the lack of a quorum.

Legal Counsel stated that according to the Charter (recently revised to include this provision) is very clear that with no quorum the meeting must adjourn.

First Selectman Weinstein said the head table can answer questions once the meeting is adjourned.

Ken Edgar (Charter Revision Committee) noted 'people can speak but cannot change numbers'.

Several people commented that they wished to speak and questioned the change in the Charter to require 130 people to be present.

Lois Ryan, Bernard Drive asked of the Charter can be amended and legal counsel said 'yes' it can.

Nina Daniel, Good Hill Rd also on the Charter Revision Committee stated that there is a minority report that opposed the 130 resident quorum.

Members of the meeting and those attending all wished Dr. JoAnn Keating, School Financial Director a warm farewell. Dr. Keating has accepted another position. Many commented on the outstanding work she has done for the schools as well as working very hard with the Board of Finance and the Board of Education.

With no further business to come before this meeting with a lack of a quorum, the meeting adjourned at 8:29 PM
