Absentee ballot applications are available at the Town Clerk's Office and on the Town of Weston website [www.westonct.gov](http://www.westonct.gov)

Note: Only the individual, immediate family member or a designee of the voter may download an application

Any qualified registered voter may vote absentee if unable to vote in person due to:

Illness or physical disability

Absence from town during voting hours

Religious beliefs which forbid secular activity on election or primary day

Active U.S. military service

Special Conditions:

If you have an unexpected illness or physical disability within six days before the polls close on Election day, you can still vote. Call the Town Clerk for more information.

If you find you can vote in person after having voted by absentee ballot, you must go to the Town Clerk's office by 10 AM on Election day to request the withdrawal of your absentee ballot. The Town Clerk will issue a signed statement to present to the moderator at your polling place so you can vote in person.

Completed ballots must be received by the Town Clerk:

**By mail or Designee** before the polls close on Tuesday, November 3, 2015

**In person** by the day before the Election, Monday, November 2, 2015
