Hi Dave,

The Norfield Rd. tree has always been a concern with our bus drivers. The drivers must cross over to the opposite lane in order to avoid contact with this tree.

I have been working here since 2003 and I recall close calls reported and one direct mirror hit. The tree creates a hazard. Another hazardous spot are the hedges that protrude onto the road across from 83 & 89 Norfield. This has been one area that I have received the most complaints about over the years.

If you would like to come for a ride on one of our buses I would be more than happy to show you exactly what I am trying to explain and where the hazards are with a large vehicle.
