

CONSERVATION COMMISSION SITE WALK MINUTES FOR APRIL 12, 2014

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Ms. Minter opened the April 12<sup>th</sup> Site Walk meeting of the Weston Conservation Commission at 8:00 a.m.

REPLACEMENT OF GODFREY ROAD WEST BRIDGE, GODFREY ROAD AND PENT ROAD (TOWN OF WESTON/CARDINAL ENGINEERING ASSOCIATES)

The Commissioner were shown areas under the bridge where scouring was at its worst. The dimensions of the new bridge were discussed as were areas of concern, such as moving the natural gas main, re-routing the water flow during work in the river bed, box culverts and the structural integrity and design of the new bridge. The bridge will have 3' concrete sides with stone facing and new guard rails. Erosion controls and landscaping were also discussed. It was noted that a catch basin will now be used so that if the river overflows, it will no longer go into the road and cause dangerous flooding and freezing.

The time frame for construction would be approximately 4 – 6 months from start to finish.
