Meeting on tapes dated 4/17/08

Vice-Chairman Schwartz opened the April 17<sup>th</sup> regular meeting of the Weston Conservation Commission at 7:56 p.m.

SET WAK DATE:

The walk date was set for May 10, 2008. The Commissioners will meet at Town Hall at 8:00 a.m.

RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS:

Fred Anderson reported that the following applications were appropriate for receipt:

- Nature Conservancy – Low 34 River Road fish ladder, Saugatuck River (Harrold)
- Spratt Builders 65 Newtown Turnpike – Extension of existing gravel drive and installation for 3 sided aluminum box culvert
- Certoma, 8 Narrowbrook pool/deck (Tuttle)

MOTION TO RECEIVE:

Mr. Schwartz made a motion to receive the applications and Mr. Failla seconded. All in favor, the motion carried (4-0).

UPDATE ON CARTBRIDGE ROAD BRIDGE:

Arthur DiCesare, from A. DiCesare Associates came forward to give an update on the project. He explained why they started working on the west side. There has been some difficulty getting easements to move the utility pole on the east side of the river. Mr. DiCesare stated that they installed coffer dams and they were working well last week. Mr. Anderson commented that he has not seen any problems with the coffer dams and he has been monitoring the project in the field. Mr. Failla expressed concern that the excavator was very close to the river bank and suggested that they not leave their equipment so close to the water's edge.

Mr. Schwartz questioned when they were going to finish the project. Mr. DiCesare stated that they have a contract date of July 2, and then there is a \$2,000/day penalty after that. Mr. Anderson noted that he has had no feed back regarding Aquarion restricting the water flow from the dams into river. Mr. DiCesare then stated that if there is too much water flow, they will stop work.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Schwartz made a motion to approve the minutes from the February, 20, 2008, February 21, 2008 and March 20, 2008 meetings and Mr. Ferdinand seconded. All in favor, the motion carried 4-0.

MOTION TO ADJOURN

Hearing no additional business, Mr. Rosenberg made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Mr. Schwartz seconded. All in favor, the meeting adjourned at 8:48 p.m.
