

Commission on Aging
Minutes
June 20, 2011

Commission members present: Helen R. de Keijzer, Peggy Anderson, Bruce Lorentzen, Nina Daniel, Susan Moore. Also present: Senior Center Director Jen Ruddy, SWCAA rep. Meta Schroeter, Dial-a-Ride driver Gordon Green, Charlene Chang Hillman, MSW of Town of Weston, and Gayle Weinstein, First Selectman (briefly).

Chair Helen R. de Keijzer called the meeting to order at 9:20 a.m.
Minutes from the June 6, 2011 meeting were approved unanimously as written.

Helen recapped some of the June 6th long-range planning discussion and asked for feedback on any additional issues. Members affirmed their support for the continuance of the senior tax abatement program and the continuing investigation into the "bus" situation/options.

Area senior survey synopsis presented by Meta and results discussed.

Meta announced that the Medicare D open enrollment period has changed: It will be from October 15 – December 7th this year and will be publicized in the Center Newsletter.

Dial-A-Ride: Gordon discussed the condition of the bus.

Commissioners discussed and laid out direction/guidance for Jen/The Center for the 2011/2012 year focusing on:

- D. Periodic activities and programs

Discussion also focused on potential new Center programming and noted the importance of communicating and working with the Friends of the Weston Senior Activities Center once the new group is established.
