

OVERVIEW

Eversource is ready to respond to impacts from forecasted high winds and heavy rain expected to arrive later this afternoon and continuing through tomorrow morning. Peak wind gusts embedded in thunderstorms could reach 50 mph. Rainfall may be 1 - 3 inches.

- We are closely reviewing weather forecasts. The National Weather Service has issued a Wind Advisory for all of Southern New England from noon today until 11 a.m. Wednesday, October 25; and a Flash Flood Watch for Hartford County from 6 p.m. tonight until 10 a.m. Wednesday.
- Eversource is closely tracking the storm and will adjust readiness activities as needed.

PUBLIC INFORMATION

Customers are reminded that if they need to use a generator, it should always be operated outdoors, as far from the house as possible. Keep it away from doors, windows and air vents to avoid carbon monoxide poisoning.

- As always, if any customers smell a gas odor in their home or business, they should leave immediately. From a safe place, they should call Eversource to report the leak at our 24/7 emergency number, 877-944-5325, or call 9-1-1. They should remain outside until Eversource can check the source of the odor.
