Families and caregivers, please join us every Wednesday for singing, dancing, and stories geared for children ages 3 –5 years old. No registration required for this type of fun.




Recycling Through Literature for Grades K-2: Every Tues. at 3:30 & 4:45PM


Loving Libraries, Literature and Crafts, Ages 3-5, 11AM; A story-craft session based on Michael Garland's Lost Dog.




Come Build With Us: Feb. 13, 11AM-12PM, Feb. 22, 3:30PM-4:30PM
