

Global Facilities Committee minutes 6/21/2013

The meeting was called to order at 10:30 am by First Selectman Weinstein.

In attendance were First Selectman Weinstein, , Melissa Koller, Superintendent Palmer, Dan Clarke, Ellen Uzenoff, Nina Daniel, members of the public.

Chair of the Board of Finance Jerry Sargent called in.

1. Discussion/decision regarding potential uses of 48 Norfield Rd.- Mr. Paul McNamara, Chairman of the Fairfield County Bank, called Ms. Weinstein to discuss the potential of selling the property to the Town. Prior to bringing the vote to purchase to Town Meeting, Ms. Weinstein would like the committee to discuss potential uses. Ideas discussed were Town offices, leasing it out as a professional building, utilizing it as a community center or leasing it out as a Bed and Breakfast. No decision was reached.
2. Discussion/decision regarding Town owned land.- Ms. Weinstein discussed the various pieces of property owned by the Town of Weston. Some pieces are deed restricted for use and most of the other pieces are the result of land given for Open Space. There may be the potential for additional development or sale of the Fromson-Strassler property.
3. Discussion/decision regarding school and town facilities- Ms. Weinstein discussed the need for a new Police Station, new Communications Center, and a place to relocate employees housed in the annex. Dr. Keating mentioned that Silver-Petrucci, an architectural firm, was hired to look at school space needs. The Committee agreed that the Town should be part of that process, as well.
