Walk in Registration: Begins on Thursday, December. 14th at 9:30 a.m. in the Recreation office at 47 Norfield Rd. if space is available.

Prior to registration online make sure you have your Web Trac user and I.D. and password setup. If you already have an account make sure your information has been updated (i.e. address, age, grade, health, etc.).
