Minutes of meeting on Wednesday, October 3, 2018

The commissioners reviewed new drawings showing two proposed options outlined by the architect, Rob Sanders. The general consensus of the Commission was a preference for the proposed new windows in the addition to match more closely to the current distinctive elongated rectangular windows of the old barn structure.
