

**Weston Historic District Commission**  
**Minutes of meeting on Wednesday, November 7, 2018**

The meeting was called to order at 8:10pm by Chairman Paul Deysenroth in the Weston Library conference room. The meeting was a continuation of a discussion of Natalia and David Bentley's proposed changes to their home located at 5 Hidden Hill Road, in the Kettle Creek Historic District. This was not a "special meeting" as posted but a regular meeting.

The commissioners reviewed revised drawings presented by architect, Rob Sanders. The design for the new windows and doors was altered to more closely resemble the current windows in the old barn structure.

Revised documentation of outlined specifications for the project were requested to be submitted to the Commission as well as a revised drawing that more clearly indicates that doors shown in the drawing were doors.

A motion was made by Lynne and seconded by Carol to approve the application pending completion of the above requested revised documentation and based on the November 7 drawings shown to the Commission. The motion passed unanimously.

The minutes of the October 3, 2018 meeting were unanimously approved; Lynne made the motion and Chris seconded it.

There was discussion of a possible Village District proposal. There was also discussion and concern expressed regarding why the Commission was not contacted in advance of a Selectman's meeting for November 8 with an agenda item to discuss Historic District #1.

The meeting adjourned at 9:10 pm.
