Trudy is a professor of German history in Minnesota, where she's teaching a seminar on women's roles in Nazi Germany and conducting interviews with Germans about how they're dealing with what they did during the war. - *Hazel Rochman, Booklist*

**Wednesday Evening Book Club - Plainsong by Kent Haruf**
