LEGAL NOTICE: The Town of Weston, CT seeks to engage a Consulting Engineering firm to provide engineering services for the preparation of contract plans and documents for the following transportation projects:

(2) Bridge Rehabilitation/Replacement Projects:

State Project No. 0157-TBD – Rehabilitation of Bridge Nos. 4351 & 4960, Davis Hill and River Road over Saugatuck River

State Project No. 0157-TBD – Replacement of Bridge No. 4964 Cavalry Road over West Saugatuck River

The Consulting Engineering firm selected may also be required to provide survey, geo-tech, hydraulic study(s), prepare environmental documents, and perform construction inspection. The projected construction cost is expected to be in the range of \$1-2 million. Work is expected to include but not limited to, removal and replacement of the Cavalry Road Bridge (#04964), beam and rail replacement, joint repairs, painting, paving, and guardrail work on the River Road Bridge (#04960) and, joint repairs and extensive wood railing repair and replacement at the Davis Hill Bridge (#04351).

Firms responding to this request should be of adequate size and sufficiently staffed to perform the assignment described above.

The Consulting Engineering firm will be evaluated and selected based on design and technical competence, the capacity and capability to perform the work within the time allotted, past record of performance, and knowledge of Federal, State, and Municipal procedures, appropriately weighted in descending order of importance.

The design fee will be negotiated on a Lump Sum basis. It is anticipated that an eight percent (8%) goal will be established as the percentage of work that must be subcontracted to Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE). The selected firm must meet all Municipal, State, and Federal affirmative action and equal employment opportunity practices.

A letter of interest, together with general information on the firm and proposed sub consultants, the firm's brochure, current Federal Form SF330, experience of the firms, and resumes of key personnel shall be addressed to: Tom Landry, Town Administrator, Weston Town Hall, 56 Norfield Road, Weston, CT 06883. Additionally, all interested firms must submit a detailed statement including the organizational structure under which the firm proposes to

conduct business. Proposed sub consultants should be clearly identified. The relationship to any “parent” firm or subsidiary firm, with any of the parties concerned, must be clearly defined.

Personnel in responsible charge of the projects will be required to possess and maintain a valid Connecticut Professional Engineer’s License. All letters of interest must be postmarked by a U.S. Post Office (if mailed) or brought to Weston Town Hall, at the above address (if hand delivered) no later than 4pm on November 22, 2016. Responses received or postmarked after this date will not be considered.
