**Commissioners present:** Rick Phillips, Beth Gralnick, Peter Ottomano, Hal Shupack and Jess DiPasquale and Jeff Eglash.

**Others present:** Patricia Sullivan (Town Legal Counsel), John Conte (Town Engineer), Dan Clark (Weston Schools), Bob Gardner, Fran Goldstein and Britta Lerner.

**Meeting called to order at 7:05 PM**

**1) Presentation to the Chief—Bob Gardner, Fran Goldstein, et. al.**

Mr. Gardner and Fran Goldstein presented Chief Troxell with a petition signed by residents of Weston thanking him for his 31 years of service with the Weston Police Dept.

**2) Update on Old Mill Road Options—Attorney Pat Sullivan, John Conte**

Discussion concerning the options that could be done on Old Mill Road to cut down on speeders and traffic.

**MOTION #1**

Commissioner DiPasquale made a motion to create a safety zone by Cobb's Mill Inn consisting of diagonal lines, traffic cones and a speed box. Commissioner Gralnick seconded the motion, all in favor.

**MOTION #2**

Commissioner Shupack made a motion to recommend that the Town Attorney and Town Engineer go before the Selectmen with a proposal to improve the road both in elevations and width. Commissioner Brady seconded the motion, all in favor.

**3) Crosswalk options on School Road—Dan Clark**

Discussion on placement of stop signs on School Road.

Commissioner DiPasquale made a motion to place a stop sign as directed close to the exit of the high school parking lot and move the existing signs closer to the “S” curve with a warning that says Stop Ahead. Commissioner Brady seconded the motion. Discussion followed. Commissioner Brady amended motion by adding yellow reflective stripes at the crosswalk. All in favor.

**4) Consideration/Approval of the minutes of the Meeting of March 6<sup>th</sup> and April 3rd, 2012**

Commissioner Shupack motioned to approve minutes of March 6, 2012, motion seconded by Commissioner Galnick, all in favor. Commissioner Eglash abstained.

Commissioner Galnick motioned to approve minutes of April 3, 2012, motioned seconded by Commissioner Brady, all in favor. Commissioner DiPasquale abstained.

**5) Presentation of Chief’s report for April, 2012**

Discussion concerning overtime for April which was the lowest in a couple years. The Chief predicts that the overtime will be less this year compared to last year. Commissioners requested that there is more Police presence on Old Mill Road during rush hour.
