1) Nissan Evantoff—Placement of Heart Safe Community Signs on Town Poles

Weston has been designated a Heart Safe community by the State of CT. Mr. Evantoff would like the Commissioners to consider allowing him to place signs (provided by the State) in town letting the community and visitors know that the town has such a distinction. First Selectman Weinstein will follow up with the state to be sure these signs can be put up on state roads. Mr. Evantoff will have another article in the Weston Forum informing the residents about Heart Safe, show the sign and that this is a state program.

Commissioner Shupack motioned that Mr. Evantoff proceed with finalizing the decision with the State as to where the signs can be placed and come back to our next meeting with a plan as to where the four signs would be located, in consultation with Chief Troxell. Motion seconded by Commissioner Eglash. All in favor.
