Please join us for the opening of Bisceglie – Scribner pond on Saturday, June 15th!! The pond, located at 154 Newtown Turnpike, will be open seven days a week from 11:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. This facility has a swimming pond, picnic area, toddler play area and featured activities throughout the season. A hand held permit is required and will be available to Weston residents only. Fees: Family - \$25.00, Individuals (ages 18 – 61), \$15.00 and free to seniors (ages 62 and up). A sitter permit is available with a Weston resident for \$15.00 (not available online).
