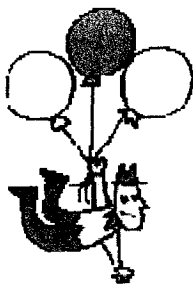

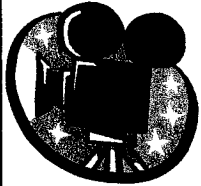

March 19th: "My Big Fat Greek Wedding"

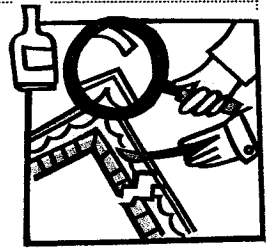

Watercolor Class w/Eileen!!

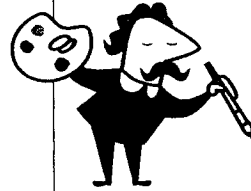

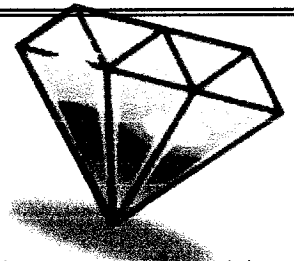

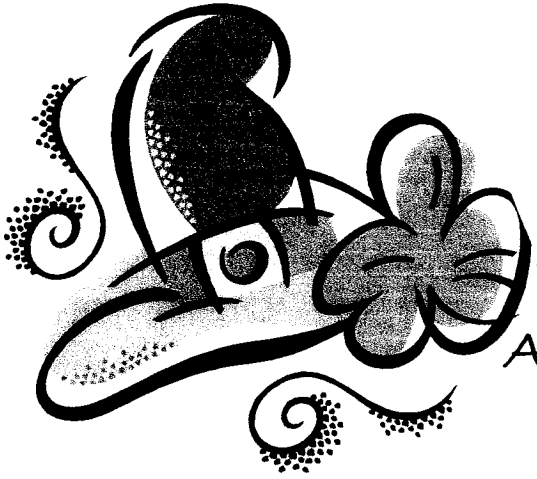
