

WESTON HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION MINUTES

HELD JUNE 1, 2011

PRESENT: Lynne Langlois, Chairperson; Paul Deysenroth, Vice Chair; Nicky Bleifeld; Roland Poirier; Carol Baldwin (alternate)

The MEETING began at 8:10 pm, presided over by Lynne Langlois and held in Weston Library Conference Room.

1. Discussion of the preservation of the Lachat house – Mrs. Baldwin:
Mrs. Langlois offered to draft a letter expressing the Commission's support for saving the Lachat farmhouse. She will circulate the letter to Commission members for comment.
There was also some discussion as to the potential merits of creating a Godfrey Historic District.
2. Replacement of sign for Den Historic District:
A motion was made by Carol Baldwin and seconded by Nicky Bleifeld to approve the allocation of Commission funds to cover the replacement costs (\$45) of a Historic District sign damaged by last winter's heavy snows. The motion was unanimously approved. The sign will be made by East Coast Signs of Bethel, CT.

The Minutes were read aloud and a motion was made to approve the Minutes by Paul Deysenroth and seconded by Roland Poirier. The motion was unanimously approved.
