

WESTON HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION MINUTES

Special Meeting

HELD May 12, 2014

The MEETING began at 2:00 pm, presided over by Lynne Langlois and held in Town Hall Meeting Room.

Selectwoman Weinstein and Police Troxell presented to the Commission the preliminary drawings for a new Police Station for Weston. Lynne Langlois, speaking on behalf of the Commission, stated that the present drawings did not have enough information for the Commission to comment on. She clarified the exact State Statute that defines the Historic District Commission's purview. Chris Kimberly pointed out that, because all sides of the building will be viewed by the public, the Commission will have to consider the building's exterior in its entirety. The Commission asked next to be presented with architectural renderings of the plan.
