Please come out and enjoy WHS Company's performance of *The Laramie Project*, a powerful documentary-style play by [Moisés Kaufman](#) and members of the [Tectonic Theater Project](#) about the reaction to the 1998 murder of Matthew Shepard, an openly gay student at the [University of Wyoming](#) in [Laramie, Wyoming](#). Shepard's death set off a nationwide debate about hate crimes and homophobia. The play draws on hundreds of interviews conducted by the theatre company with inhabitants of the town, company members' own journal entries and published news reports. The material is uniquely presented in a series of short scenes in which a small group of actors portray a multitude of characters.

The performances will be held on: Friday, November 14th at 8pm, Saturday, November 15th at 8pm and Sunday, November 16th at 3pm. Tickets are \$12 for adults a\$8 for seniors and students.
