UPCOMING VOTES

Persons eligible to vote must be an elector of the Town of Weston or a U.S. citizen of the age of eighteen years or more who, jointly or severally, is liable to the town, for taxes assessed against him on an assessment of not less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) on the Grand List of Weston, or who would be liable if not entitled to an exemption. Properties held in an LLC or Trust do not afford voting privileges off the Grand List.

At the conclusion of the meeting, Adjourned Referendum voting will commence in Weston High School Library. ***Adjourned Referendum voting will continue on Saturday, April 28 in the Town Hall Meeting Room from 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM.***

Absentee ballots will be available through the Town Clerk's Office beginning Thursday, April 19 through Friday, April 27. The Town Clerk will accept Absentee Ballots from a voter's designee on Saturday, April 28 from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm, if the voter is unable to vote at the polls for one of the reasons stipulated on the application.

Registration Deadlines:

- **ATBM and April 18 voting:** Voter registrations received by mail, online or in person by: 12:00 pm on Wednesday, April 18, 2018.
- **Adjourned Referendum April 28 voting:** Voter registrations received by mail, online or in person by 12:00 pm on Friday, April 27, 2018.

CURBSIDE VOTING

In the event that an elector is present at the polling place but is unable to gain access to the polling place due to a temporary incapacity, the elector may request that the ballot be brought to him or her. The registrars of voters or the assistant registrars of voters, as the case may be, shall take such ballot, along with a privacy sleeve to such elector. The elector shall show identification, in accordance with the provisions of this section. The elector shall forth with mark the ballot in the presence of the election officials in such manner that the election officials shall not know how the ballot is marked. The elector shall place the ballot in the privacy sleeve. The election officials shall mark the elector's name on the official voter list, manually on paper or electronically, as having voted in person and deliver such ballot and privacy sleeve to the voting tabulator where such ballot shall be placed into the tabulator, by the election official, for counting.

VOTER REGISTRATION

Eligibility Requirements:

- U.S. citizen
- Resident of Weston
- At least 17 years of age (as long as you will turn 18 by Election Day on November 6, 2018)
- Completed confinement and parole, if previously convicted of a felony

ABSENTEE BALLOT INFORMATION

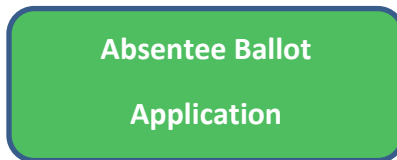
For questions on Absentee Ballots, contact the Town Clerk's office at 203-222-2616

Any qualified registered voter may vote absentee **ONLY** if unable to vote in person due to:

- Illness or physical disability
- Absence from town during all voting hours
- Serving as poll worker in polling places other than their own
- Religious beliefs which forbid secular activity on election or primary day
- Active U.S. military service

To receive an absentee ballot, a voter must:

- Complete an absentee ballot application, available either in-person at Weston Town Hall or by download here:



- Return the completed application for processing either in person or by mail to Town Clerk, Town of Weston, PO Box 1007, 56 Norfield Road, Weston, CT 06883
- Absentee ballots become available to electors on October 6, 2017 for the November 7, 2017 General Election
- In order for your vote to count, the completed absentee ballot must be received in the Town Clerk's Office by Election Day

Special Conditions:

- If you have an unexpected illness or physical disability within six days before the polls close on Election Day, you can still vote. Please call the Town Clerk's office (203) 222-2616 for more information.
- If you find you can vote in person after having voted by absentee ballot, you must go to the Town Clerk's office **before 10:00 am on Election Day** to request withdrawal of your absentee ballot. The Town Clerk will issue a signed statement to present to the election Moderator at the polling place so you may vote in person.
