


Drawing Classes for Children



Althea H. Ericsson has been an artist since she was about six years old. Trained in the academic structure of the Masters. Althea attended Fairleigh Dickinson University, NY School of Interior Design Parsons and Yale. Her Art Associations have included Silvermine Institute, New Canaan Society of Art, and Woman Artist of the West, Southwest Indian Art Association, and Portrait Society of America. She participates in numerous art shows in the Northeast and Southwest. Recent awards include People's Choice of best portrait painting titled "Secrets," at the Rowayton Art Center. Her portraits are in private collections commissioned by owners. Althea has taught oil painting at the Norwalk Community College for the past eight years in the Lifetime Learners program. The academics of formal art are taught, however Althea allows her students to establish their own creative style. Althea believes that artist expression is a journey we take, when we stop to look and enjoy the beauty around us.

Susan Jackson lived in CA for 12 years where she worked as an exhibit designer, a theatrical scenic designer, and a Walt Disney Imagineer. Always knowing in her heart that she wanted to teach children, in 1990 Susan found her way to the front of the classroom at the Monart School for the Arts in Santa Monica, CA. Since returning to CT Susan has been arranging and teaching drawing/art classes throughout Fairfield County. In 1999 Susan opened the Paint, Draw & More! Studio in Georgetown, CT and along with teaching children and adult classes, has been teaching training workshops for teachers to use drawing as a teaching tool in the classrooms of public schools.
