

**Public Hearing May 5, 2011**  
**Bulky Printed Material on Private Property**

At 7:00pm Ms. Weinstein opened the public hearing.

The purpose of the public hearing is to accept comment concerning the proposed Weston ordinance regarding Bulky Printed Material on Private Property.

Margaret Wirtenberg, Wilson Road- Asked if we were creating something that is going to be more complicated, and wanted to know what our plan was for enforcing it. Ms. Weinstein said the Code Enforcement Officer is responsible for all enforcement actions.

Ms. Weinstein said that the first time the company is allowed to drop the material at the driveway. There needs to be a telephone number, an address, or an email address for the resident to opt out and let the company know that they no longer wish to receive this. The company then has 90 days to comply. If they have asked the company to stop dropping things off and they still are doing so, then the resident should call Town Hall or the Code Enforcement Officer and let them know.

Mr. Muller said that the wording is such that it gives the resident the opportunity to opt out and it is up to the individual resident to make that decision for themselves.
