

**SPECIAL JOINT BOARD OF SELECTMEN AND CEMETERY COMMITTEE
MEETING**

May 1, 2010

Present: First Selectman Gayle Weinstein; Selectman David Muller; Selectman Dan Gilbert; Cemetery Committee Members, members of the public

The meeting was called to order by Chairwoman Weinstein at 11:05 am.

The Selectmen and members of the cemetery committee will walk and discuss the proposed cemetery sites of Jarvis, Moore-Lord's Highway and Fromson Strassler –

The Selectmen and Cemetery Committee walked all three sites. Pros and Cons of each were discussed.

Jarvis- Neighbors expressed concern about their wells, which abut the property. There was also concern about the size of the property and the number of burials it can hold. The pros were that it was centrally located, right off the main road.

Moore- Beautiful piece of property. The actual cemetery site within the property has not been established yet. There are ground water issues (see attached letter from Town Engineer.)

Fromson-Strassler- Once you walk past the power lines, it is a very large, pretty piece of property. Definitely offers room for expansion of cemetery. We must consider potential future uses of the whole property when siting the cemetery. Major issue is that the only access is down a private, skinny lane.

It was decided that discussion will continue at a later Board of Selectmen's meeting. The Selectmen have asked for a financial and operating plan.

Selectman Gilbert made a motion to adjourn at 12:45 am. Seconded by Selectman Weinstein. Motion carried unanimously.
