This weekend...Saturday family activity: Free and fun - July hikes in Weston. Weston Walks Program.

School Campus Hike: This hike is on Saturday July 11th. The walk leaves from Town Hall at 9:00 AM.

Dr. Tom Failla will lead this extraordinary nature hike over the school campus. Tom served on Weston's Conservation Commission from 1992 - 2013 and is very familiar with the campus, the natural systems in and around the campus, and its development going back to the 1960s. This is an easy walk on flat surfaces with some sidewalks and roads.

Don't Get Lost in Devil's Den Hike: A summer walk in the woods of the Den. On Tuesday, July 21st Ray Rauth will lead the Don't Get Lost in Devil's Den Hike. The hike leaves at 10:00 AM from the Pent Road Parking lot at the Den. The hike is rain or shine – only dangerous conditions – high winds or lightening – will cancel. It is a moderate hike of about three miles.

The purpose of the hike is to teach folks how to feel secure in the Den while enjoying a pleasant walk in the cool summer forest.
