

Weston Public Library to Hold Community Forum

The Weston Community is invited to attend an Open Forum at the Weston Public Library on Sunday, February 23rd from 2:30-3:30 pm. The Board of Trustees of the Weston Public Library is holding the Forum as a part of its current strategic and space planning process. "The needs of our community are the driving force behind our planning...We want to understand how we can serve current and future needs better." said Karen Tatarka, Director of the Weston Public Library.

The Public Forum is just one part of the Board's outreach to Weston residents. A Town-wide survey will be launched on February 24th to solicit the broadest possible community input. The survey, which should take approximately 10 minutes or so to complete, will be available online and in print at the Library and other locations throughout Town. The Board encourages residents to complete the survey on line, if possible, to streamline tabulation of the results.

As the recent beneficiary of an extremely generous bequest from long-time Weston resident, Franc Vitale, the Board is able to continue its comprehensive review of the Community's needs with respect to our Library's space and the services we may provide and to implement a comprehensive renovation of the Library.
