We have submitted an application to build a garage on the property at 18 Good Hill Road. No garage currently exists there. We have looked at many alternative locations for the garage placement. The best location is in the backyard which abuts River Road Ext. We tried to place the garage in the front of the property, but were met with resistance from multiple neighbors.

We are requesting that an official "curb cut" be allowed. There currently exists a driveway entrance to the rear of the property, which predates our purchase of the property.

We are requesting a variance for the gravel driveway to be 5' from the property line as this will permit safe negotiation from River Road Ext. This location is the only viable placement for the garage. We will make every effort to keep the structure aesthetically pleasing.

The FY2013-14 DPW budget anticipated the paving of nine roadways. The funds available (\$400,000 budget plus \$85,000 in carry over funds) would have been about \$60,000 shy of the amount needed to complete this work. However, in the closing hours of the Legislature we received a doubling of Town Road Aid to \$250,000. The budget was built on an estimate of receiving the same TRA as last year, which was \$125,000, and is included in the \$400,000 appropriation. The extra \$125,000 will allow us to complete all nine roadways, and have a \$60,000 surplus. Our plan is to complete the paving, and apply the estimated \$60,000 surplus to the 2014 paving season. Seven of the nine roads have been paved to date (Jana Drive, Brookwood, Cavalry, Buttonball, Church Lane, Powderhorn, and Lords Highway East) . The final two to be completed are Hillcrest and Old Orchard (includes Hills End).


