

## **Town of Weston** **Storm Related Update**

Updated November 5, 9:00am

- CL&P has given us an amended estimate of Saturday, to restore power to 99% of Weston customers. At this time, 6% of residents do not have power restored.
- The comfort station will be open today from 6am-9pm. A decision about Sunday will be made later today. **Please use the middle school pool entrance in the front of the building. Showers and coffee will be available.**
- **Town Hall will be open today from 8-4 and closed tomorrow. The Library will be open today from 10-4 and tomorrow from 12-4.**
- We recommend parents exercise caution this evening as children go out trick-or-treating. There continue to be numerous obstacles in the form of trees/limbs and wires in various locations throughout town. Streets that look dark should be avoided.

- The Town of Weston will be accepting tree debris as a result of the October Snow Storm at the Transfer Station, free of charge. Debris drop off will be accepted from Monday, November 7 - Friday, November 18, Monday through Fridays only. Hours are from 8:00am - 3:45pm.
