This year's seasonal flu vaccine contains all the flu strains which are thought to most likely occur in the United States this flu season. Only one flu vaccination is needed this year to protect against these prominent flu strains, including H1N1.

The seasonal flu vaccine is made from highly purified, egg grown inactivated virus and will not cause people to get the flu. Most people have no side effects from influenza vaccines. Flu shots are given by injection into the muscle of the upper arm. This may cause soreness for a day or two at the injection site and occasionally may also cause a fever or achiness for one or two days.

A fee of \$32 will be charged for the seasonal flu vaccine. Medicare (Part B), Anthem Blue Cross/Blue Shield and checks/cash will be accepted. Those who are covered by these health care plans must bring their cards to the clinic. Those who may be covered by other health insurance plans must pay with cash.

TO SPEED UP APPOINTMENTS, REMEMBER

Wear clothing with loose sleeves or short sleeves

AND ALSO

Check with your doctor if you have a serious egg, chicken, or thimerosal allergy, may be pregnant, are ill with fever, or have/had Guillain-Barre Syndrome.

No one will be refused vaccination due to inability to pay.
