1. *Community Garden and Children's Garden/Greenhouse* - Kat McConnaughey , Terry Cho
  - a. Compost Bin needs to be emptied and all vines removed – Ellen and Terry will do-not a priority until later
  - b. Discuss moving bins in community garden to the greenhouse area.
  - c. Offer from Stephan Garbee and his mother, Lynn to help with the composting situation. Stephan is going to school locally and is very interested in learning about composting and implementing it for the Town
  - d. Terry discuss increasing the CG garden to include more produce to give to worthy causes such as CHIP in Bridgeport which feeds children who don't get to eat on the weekends

  - a. machine shop cleanout continues - **need to relocate the antiques in the corner of the machine shop (Carol where would you like them put?)**
