

**Board of Selectmen Regular Meeting Minutes**  
**Thursday, September 3, 2020 at 7:30pm**  
**Meeting was held virtually due to COVID-19**

- 1- **Call to Order:** First Selectman Spaulding called meeting to order at 7:30. Also present were Selectwoman Samantha Nestor, Selectman Stephan Grozinger, Town Administrator Jonathan Luiz and Weston Residents
- 2- **Pledge of Allegiance:** The Pledge was recited
- 3- **Diversity Committee Interviews.** The Board of Selectmen interviewed Denise Massingale-Lamb, Christie Stewart, Martin Mohabeer and Gillian Blunshi. **No motion**
- 4- **Marketing Committee candidate interview:** tabled
- 5- **Interview of candidates for the Commission on Children and Youth:** The Board of Selectmen interviewed Gillian Donovan and Adam Shuty. **No motion**
- 6- **Discussion/decision to appoint Anthony Kesselmark to the Economic Vitality Committee:** The Board of Selectmen interviewed Anthony Kesselmark . **No motion**
- 7- **Overview of Weston Youth Services programming for Fall 2020, given COVID-19:** Weston Youth Services Program Director, Charlene Monn, spoke about the initiatives they took when schools shut down in March. Ms. Monn spoke about virtual programs and specifically how they have put together 27 virtual programs for the Fall. Mr.Luiz thanked Ms. Monn for her great success with the WOW program.
- 8- **Update on FY 20/21 tax collection:** First Selectman Spaulding updated the Board stating we are in very good shape taking into account approximately \$500,000 of deferments. Mr. Luiz added he compared this fiscal year to last year difference is due to the 90 deferral. The Tax Collector said we have hit \$100,000 in revenue from conveyance taxes, which we haven't seen since since 2005.
- 9- **Property Tax Refunds:** Selectwoman Nestor approved Property Tax Refunds totaling \$17,040.99 as presented. Selectman Grozinger seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
- 10- **Minutes approval:** Selectman Grozinger moved to approve the Board of Selectmen minutes of July 16<sup>th</sup>, August 20<sup>th</sup> and August 25<sup>th</sup>. Selectwoman Nestor seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
- 11- **Adjournment:** Selectwoman Nestor moved to adjourn at 9:17pm. Selectman Grozinger seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
