

FREE ELECTRONICS RECYCLING FOR WESTON RESIDENTS

First Selectman Chris Spaulding would like to remind residents that they may, **free of charge**, bring their **unwanted electronics** to the Weston Transfer Station located at 237 Godfrey Road East. Transfer Station phone is (203) 222-2668. Hours are: Monday through Friday from 8:00am-3:45pm and Saturdays from 8:00am-2:45pm.

A sticker is required for any residential vehicle delivering solid waste, bulky waste, or recyclables to the Weston Transfer Station. The sticker will be issued free to Weston residents with the motor vehicle tax bills each June, and is valid for one year.

If you need more than one sticker, or if you are a new resident, please call or visit the Selectmen's Office at Town Hall, 56 Norfield Road, (203) 222-2656. You will need a copy of your car registration and proof of residency. Vehicle stickers also allow residents the use of parking areas to town parks.

All electronic equipment is safely packaged by Take 2 and transported to their facility for responsible and secure recycling.

Accepted materials include, but are not limited to: Computers, Laptops, Printers, Fax Machines, Monitors, TVs, Cell Phones, Tablets, Video Games, game consoles, VCR/DVD Machines, Remotes, Keyboards, Computer Mice, Modems, Small Appliances, and Stereo Equipment. **Unaccepted materials include**: smoke detectors, ballasts, propane tanks, paint, household hazardous waste and appliances containing Freon, i.e. air conditioners, refrigerators, and dehumidifiers.

Take 2 Inc. is a Waterbury based electronics recycler. Take 2 is approved by the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection as a Covered Electronics Recycler in conjunction with Connecticut's Electronics Recycling Law, RCSA 22a-638-1.

Residents may also, free of charge, bring their unwanted electronics to Take 2 Inc.'s facility located at 567 South Leonard Street, Building One, Waterbury, CT. Hours are Monday through Friday from 7am-3:30pm and Saturdays from 8am-Noon. Additionally, residents may bring their electronics to any of Take 2's electronics recycling events.
