WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR COURSE

This course is for certification to teach progression level swimming classes and other water safety courses through the **American Red Cross Learn to swim** program.

This will be a Blended Learning Class, class time in the pool and online with the American Red Cross. All dates noted below, will be pool session dates. Online class time will be on students own schedule.

Prerequisites: Minimum age 16 upon completion of the course. Successfully complete a swimming pretest and must successfully demonstrate swim strokes and skills.

Registration: begins online, www.westonct.gov/parksandrec, February 19th. You can also drop off a check, payable to Town of Weston, at the Parks and Recreation office at 47 Norfield Rd.

Note: materials will not be given out without payment. You will be notified when the materials are available for pick up.

Online class will begin March 3rd. You will receive an email from the instructor with link to the American Red Cross WSI Blended Learning class on or before March 3. There will be an additional fee to the ARC to sign up for the online class.
