Notice of Public Hearing Dec. 10, 2024 at 4:30 pm via Zoom regarding the Nov. 18, 2024 posting of a Tree Removal Notice at the southwest corner of White Birch Road and White Birch Ridge Road. The main reason for the notice on a 35 in DBH oak in the town right of way is both the Police Chief and a nearby property owner requested the removal after a two-car motor vehicle accident at the intersection. Also, in the official police accident investigation report, site line was cited as a contributing factor. A written comment in support of the removal was received from a resident at 12 White Birch, the mother of the driver of one of the cars involved in the accident. A letter of opposition was received from a resident at 1 White Birch Ridge.

Under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes, Sec. 23-59. Powers and duties of tree wardens, the tree warden is required to conduct a public hearing if the tree warden receives any objections in writing within ten days of the posting. Such a written objection has been received. Pursuant to Public Act 22-3, the Tree Warden will conduct a public hearing on Dec. 10, 2024 at 4:30 pm via Zoom.
