Board of Police Chairman Muller called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM.

Consideration/Approval January 6, 2026 meeting minutes Board of Police Chairman Muller made a request to approve the January 6, 2026 meeting minutes, Board of Police Commissioner Brendsel seconded, Board of Police Commissioner Dembishack abstained and unanimously approved.

Board of Police Commissioner Vice Chairman Ferrara made a request to remove

the discussion of plans for public meeting regarding Trust Act off the agenda, Board of Police Commissioner Kozlowsky seconded, it passed by majority vote.

Chief's Report – OT/Budget – Chief Henion reported to the Board of Police Commissioners we conducted 292 traffic posts, 83 Motor Vehicle Stops.

Chief Henion discussed the budget with the Board of Police Commissioners and the SRO MOU between the schools and the police department allowing limited access to the power school program for dispatch.

Chairman Muller made a motion to approve the SRO MOU between the schools and the police department. Board of Police Commissioner Dembishack seconded, and unanimously approved.

Chief Henion reported to the Commissioners that our police commissioners recommendation requested \$50,000.00 to replace state traffic grant that is not being reinstated for 2026-2027. He stated that Chairman Muller reported that the 1st Selectwoman Nestor is cutting \$25,000 from the police departments budget for traffic enforcement. Discussion ensued among the Board of Police Commissioners.

Board of Police Chairman Muller made a motion to reaffirm its support for the Police Department budget proposal for 2026-2027. Board of Police Commissioner Dembishack moved, Board of Police Commissioner Ezzes seconded, and unanimously approved.

Grant Updates / Donations / Vote – None at this time.

No additional business for commission consideration at this time.

Board of Police Chairman Muller made a request to go into Executive Session at 7:36 PM, Board of Police Commissioner Ezzes seconded, and unanimously approved.
